



What's New in CRMS?



Annual TIBRS Changes

The information below highlights the changes required by FBI and TBI for data submissions through TnCop. These changes must be implemented on July 1, 2016 for data submissions that will occur in August.

2016 Changes New FBI Changes: Offenses:

1. Animal Cruelty (720) – Society Crime Animal Cruelty as a Group A offense to include expansion of Data Element 12 (Criminal Activity Type)
2. Computer Hacking/Invasion (26G)
3. Identity Theft (26F) **See #3 below in Tennessee Changes**
 - a. Error Message – applicable offense checks per FBI Specs
4. Criminal Activity Code Expansion – Animal Cruelty
Expansion of Data Element 12 – Criminal Activity would include **four** additional data values: simple/gross neglect (A); intentional abuse and torture (I); organized abuse (F); and animal sexual abuse (S).
Error Messages for Animal Cruelty
 - a. 219 – Data can only be entered for specific offenses (Type Criminal Activity)
 - b. 220 - Data must be entered for specific offenses (A, F, I and S only)
5. Location Code Changes
 - a. Cyberspace (58) **See #1 below in Tennessee Changes.**
6. Edit Check Change – Change FBI error code 560 (at least one offender must be different gender than victim) for Statutory Rape Offense – offender and victim may be same gender for Statutory Rape – Edit 560 does not change for other offenses – victim and offender must be different gender.

Tennessee Changes

1. Add 2nd location code field – FILE LAYOUT IMPACT - adds two spaces to offense segment
 - a. Use of Cyberspace as location - Two codes are mandatory if cyberspace is one of the locations – cyberspace must be second location code. The first code entered will be primary and submitted to the FBI.
 - b. Offenses that do not have cyberspace as one of the locations may include two offense location codes. For example, an offense occurs in a restaurant parking lot. We would want to see parking lot as the first location code and restaurant as the second location code.

Error Messages

- i. Cyberspace may not be reported as first location code
 - ii. Cyberspace cannot be the only location code reported.
 - iii. All other edits that apply to first location code will also apply to second location code reported dependent upon offenses reported.
 - c. Tennessee will submit the first location reported to the FBI.
2. Identity Theft - TN will accept Identity Offense but incident must include at least one of the following offenses 120,220,250,270,26A-E,26G, 23A,23B,23D,23F,23G,23H,240,210 or att 510.
 - a. Error Messages
 - i. Identity Theft offense must have Identity Theft Flag reported as “Y”
 - ii. Identity Theft offense must be reported with additional offense(s) in the incident.
 - iii. Identity Theft is reported as an offense with Identity Theft flag as “Y”. A second offense must also have the Identity Theft flag marked as “Y” in the incident.
3. Computer Hacking/Invasion
 - a. Error Message - TN
 - i. Identity Theft Flag must be reported as “Y” or “N” – cannot be blank.
4. New Offense – Negligent Vehicular Manslaughter (09D)
 - a. Can report DUI as separate Group B Arrest – different incident number
 - b. Error Message – TN
 - i. Offender suspected of Using must have Drugs and/or Alcohol indicated
 - ii. Weapon can only be vehicle
 - iii. Victim information must be entered
 - c. Tennessee will not submit this information to the FBI.
5. New Location Codes
 - a. Auto Salvage/Junkyard (77)
 - b. Carport (78)
 - c. Firearms Retail Store (79)
 - d. Library (80)
 - e. Loan/Cash Advance (81)
 - f. Pawn Shop (82)
 - g. Tattoo parlor (83)

NOTE: These location codes will be reported as “Other” to the FBI.

6. New Property Description Codes

- a. Gift Cards (81)
- b. Lottery Tickets (82)
- c. Mailbox-residential (83)
- d. Mailbox – U.S. Postal Service (84)
- e. Portable Restroom (85)
- f. Toys (86)
- g. Van (MV Type) (87)
- h. Video Game Consoles/Games (89)

NOTE: Property code of Van (87) will be reported as “Other Motor Vehicles” to the FBI.

NOTE: The following property codes – Gift Cards (81), Lottery Tickets (82), Mailbox – residential (83), Mailbox – U.S. Postal Service (84), Portable Restroom (85), Toys (86), and Video Game Consoles/Games (89) - will be reported as “Other – 77” to the FBI. Values will be combined in the FBI file if more than one property mapped to “Other” for FBI submission.

7. Distance Range for Officer Involved Shooting segments – second distance field – second field – FILE LAYIUT IMPACT – will increase segment length by 3 spaces

8. Link property descriptions in each loss type to a reported offense – FILE IMPACT – offense segment changes

- a. Utilize **new** spaces 327-356 in property segment
- b. Error Messages
 - i. Each property description must include a reported offense
 - ii. Property offense cannot be blank
 - iii. Property offense must be reported as one of the incident offenses
- c. Tennessee will not submit this information to the FBI.

9. Animal Cruelty may have property segment of Seized – only should be reported if property is seized in the incident.

- a. Reported property types allowed – Pets, Livestock and Money
- b. Error messages
 - i. Reported property seized may only be pets, livestock or money
 - ii. Seized is the only property loss type allowed.
- c. Tennessee will not submit this information to the FBI.
